**We're excited to announce the plans for the next round of exhibits, Landscapes/Seascapes.**

On November 14<sup>th</sup> Mike Dooley will present a program on Landscapes and Seascapes photography. To compliment that program, the next exhibit and the fall online exhibit will be seascape and landscape images.

**Schedule:**

- October 21<sup>st</sup>- digital images (one or two) should be sent to [nptphotoguild@gmail.com](mailto:nptphotoguild@gmail.com) for consideration into the exhibit
- October 26<sup>th</sup> (or sooner)- photographers will be notified if the submissions have been accepted for the exhibit.
- November 9<sup>th</sup>-12:15 – 3 pm- printed and framed images will be dropped off at the Edward King House.
- November 9<sup>th</sup>- 12:15 – 3 pm- will also be the date Cuba images can be picked up.
- January or February 2019- images removed and next exhibit images dropped off.

**Exhibit information:**

- The Landscape/Seascape exhibit is open only to current members of the Newport Photographers' Guild.
- Members may submit one or two images.
- There is no fee to exhibit.
- If a digital image is submitted for the Landscape/Seascape exhibit, it is a requirement that a printed and framed copy be submitted for hanging if the image is selected for the exhibition
- Frank Leith will curate the exhibit and select the images to include. Selection will be based on available space in addition to image quality.
- No image will be accepted for exhibition with any side longer than 30".
- No image will be accepted for exhibition that does not have a wired back for hanging in the gallery.
- To enhance the exhibit, it would be best if all images were in a simple black frame but frame choice is at the discretion of the photographer.
- The printed image will be displayed in the ballroom of the Edward King House.
- The digital image will be displayed on the Newport Photo Guild web site in our Fall online exhibit.
- Frank will critique the images for the online portion of the program.

As we continue to explore new ways to enjoy our new venue and create opportunities for our members to share their work, we hope you'll choose to participate.
